## Highway Cautions

The State of California cannot confirm that this route meets all of the criteria set forth in Section 1000 of the State's Highway Design Manual. It is the responsibility of the event organizers to inform orally and in writing each participant to ride with caution.

- **Old Creek is narrow and winding - Ride Single File**
- **Santa Rita Road is narrow and winding - Ride Single File**
- **10 miles of Santa Rita as it climbs up and over the ridge is graded dirt - Caution: Ride With Care**
- **Oak View Road is a narrow winding single lane graded dirt road with short sight lines - Caution: Ride With Care**
- **Fast traffic on Highway 46 - Use Shoulder**
- **Long exposed descent on 46 - Slow if Side Winds Present**
- **Fast traffic on Highway 1 - Use Shoulder**
- **Move Right to let faster riders pass within the shoulder**
- **Rumble Strips along Highway 1**

## Safe Cycling Practices

1. Ride as far to the right on roads as practicable
  - Ride on the shoulder of the road when it is adequately wide and safe
  - Move left as required to avoid hazards
  - Take the lane when it would put you in danger for a vehicle to pass
  - Take the lane to make a left turn
2. Call out approaching vehicles: "Car Up;" "Car Back"
  - Move right as practicable and into single file to permit vehicles to pass
3. Point out road hazards
4. Signal your intentions and call it out: "Stopping"
5. Pass other riders on the left and call out: "On Your Left"
6. Leave the road completely when stopping. Choose or move to a spot where a SAG vehicle can completely leave the road when stopping to assist.
7. Abide by the California Driver's Handbook - Section 7: "Laws and Rules of the Road"

## Course Hours

Course opens at 7:00am. Riders that start before their staged start time may reach rest stops before they are open. The course closes at 5:00pm. Riders on the course after 5:00pm will not have SAG support.

## Communication

All SAG vehicles and Rest Stops have HAM operators to support communications during the ride.
